



Tournament Fact Sheet



The Barclays is returning to Bethpage State Park since the Long Island course previously hosted the tournament in 2012. There are five courses, in increasing order of difficulty; they are the Yellow, Green, Blue, Red and Black Courses. In 2002, the Black Course became the first publicly owned and operated course to host the U.S. Open. The tournament was won by Tiger Woods, the only golfer who was able to score under par for the tournament, and broke USGA attendance records. The Black Course also hosted the 2009 U.S. Open, which was won by Lucas Glover.

2014 CHAMPION: Hunter Mahan, 270 (-14), The Ridgewood Country Club
